Alterations in the gut microbiome have been associated with many of the factors that affect bone health. These have been shown to influence chronic conditions associated with impaired bone mass and bone quality, including obesity, diabetes, and inflammatory bowel disease. Current research into the use of probiotics for skeletal health are proving positive, encouraging future studies to determine if the gut microbiota composition is a potential biomarker for fracture prediction and if it is to be a novel therapeutic target for bone conditions.
